Supervisor Schrantz opened the Special Meeting at 10:10 a.m. to review the tentative budget for 2022.

Supervisor Schrantz stated this tentative budget shows a five-cent increase. per 1,000. Supervisor Schrantz reviewed with the board where the increases and adjustments were made. He stated the increase is due to pending issues, one being the Union is asking for more money for the Highway workers, the Union saying they are underpaid compared to other townships. He told board members he will be negotiating with the Union this Friday. He asked the board members to review the tentative budget and suggest any changes they feel needed.

Supervisor Schrantz told the Board Code Officer Wendy Spinuzza passed and is in the top three on the eligible list for Inspection Officer. This will move her from a provisional position to permanent Inspection Officer.

With no further business, on a motion of Council Miller, seconded by Council Farrell the meeting adjourned at 10:36 a.m. Carried unanimously.
