Supervisor Schrantz stated there are still issues with the railroad on Forest Ave. Trains are stopped and blocking the crossing for extended periods of time. Residents on Forest Ave. have no other way out.

Dennis Dorgi of Ellicott Road told the Board the rain storm washed out his water line, he and his family were without water for 3 days. He stated he does not know where to go and needs help. Supervisor Schrantz told Mr. Dorgi he will make some phone calls and try to resolve this issue.

NORTH CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY WATER DISTRICT:

FUEL DEPOT:
